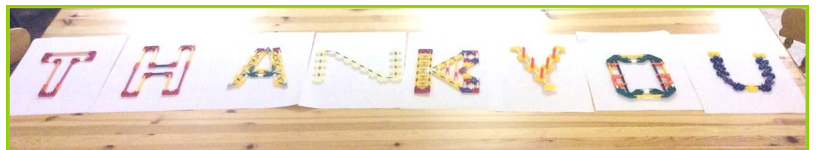
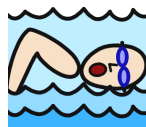


hoping to help our students to develop their motor skills, improve confidence and self awareness, learn self calming techniques and facilitate better control of their emotions.
