This Easter Holiday we will be running holiday schemes for young people aged 5- 19 years with a diagnosis of Autism on a number of the following days:

29th March – 1st April 2016
and
4th April – 8th April 2016

At
YMCA, 200 Bunbury Road, Northfield B31 2DL (for 8-19 years)
or
Kingsbury School, Kingsbury Rd, Erdington B24 8RE (for 8-19 years)
or
Cannon Hill House, Russell Road, Moseley, B13 8RD (for 5-8 years)

The sessions will run from 10am -3pm.
One to one support is available as necessary.

Please complete the attached tear off form opposite and apply according to the venue and dates that you would like your child to attend. We will allocate according to age and need but cannot guarantee how many days we can offer each family.

Cut off date for applications is **Friday 29th January 2016**

We will not be able to accept applications after the cut off date. We aim to confirm the day/s allocated to you within a maximum of two weeks after the application closing date. If you do not hear from us within two weeks please contact us ASAP. Where e-mail addresses have been provided, confirmations will be sent via e-mail.

There is a charge for this service of £12 a day and each day allocated will use 5 hours of your 100 hour short breaks allowance (if you wish to self fund the space to avoid using your short breaks allowance, charges will be at a different rate). Subsidised places are available for those on low income. For more information please ask whilst applying for your place.
