Education, Health & Care Plan Conversion Update

The process whereby students' Statement of Special Educational Needs are transferred to Education, Health and care Plans (EHCP) will continue this year.

Within the coming few weeks, Sharon Woolley, our Inclusion Manager will be contacting parents of current Year 9 students and Year 11 students who have joined the school this year to organise pre-conversion meetings where she will explain the conversion process and support parents to fill in parts of the EHCP on the students' history and specific needs. Conversion meetings will be held in early November.
