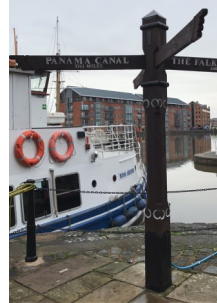

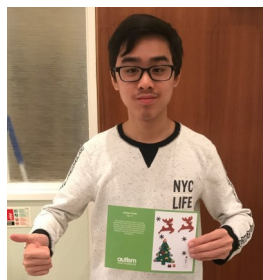
For those students who have not been invited to collect an award this year, we hope you will work even harder so that you and your parents will be with us at the next Awards Evening!
